before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June there
next following then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to satisfy Day Scott of two pounds five
shillings and Eleven pence Curr: money of Maryland and two hundred and twenty six pounds of tobacco which to the
same Day Scott in our same Court before our Justices at dividing Creek were adjudged for his Damages which he had by
Occasion of a certain promise and Assumption to the same Day by the afo William in the County afo made and not
performed wherof he is Convict and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the
person or persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they be and appears before our Justices
of our County Court to be held afo to shew Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels or Credits afo
