Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the several Goods and Chattels so aforesaid -  
are valued and appraised to the value of Two pounds Six Shillings and five pence curr. money of Maryland and  
Seven hundred and One pounds of tobacco be condemned as the proper goods and Chattels of the aforesaid  
William King toward Satisfaction into the aforesaid Day Scott the aforesaid Two pounds six Shillings and  
Eleven pence currant money of Maryland and Two hundred and Twenty Six pounds of tobacco as all Costs and Charges  
accruing by means of the attachment aforesaid and that the said Day Scott have hereof Judgment according to act  
of Assembly in such Case made and provided &c

Complaint was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Francis

R<sup>d</sup>. Francis Brooks. Brooks late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Francis Brooks of said County if  
he should be found in his County and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his  
Lordship, County Court of Somerset to be held and riding Creek the first Tuesday of June and thereon and  
Seven hundred and forty Two to answer unto William Rowley of aske that he render unto him the sum of Twenty  
pounds curr. money of Maryland which to him he does and unjustly detains & and the same day is given to the r<sup>d</sup>.

John Handif gent. nowhere returned that he had taken the r<sup>d</sup> Francis Brooks whose body he sent this day he had  
ready to answer the r<sup>d</sup> William Rowley of the r<sup>d</sup> planer to him it was commanded -

And hereupon at the prayer of the r<sup>d</sup> William Rowley the r<sup>d</sup> Francis Brooks is now judged to give special  
bail to the action of - Thereupon against William Lane of Somerset County Gent. present herein Court in his  
proper person undertaken for the said Francis Brooks Likewise the said Francis Brooks present herein Court in his proper  
person affirmed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the planer aforesaid should be rendered for the same -  
William Rowley against the same Francis Brooks or that he the same Francis Brooks should be therein Convict  
that then he the said Francis Brooks should pay and discharge unto the said William Rowley the Judgment of the Court  
hereupon
