as all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment aforesaid - Whereupon certain Robert Jenckins Henry of Somerset County Gentleman present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Day Court according to act of assembly in such case provided that in case the said William King should at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said Day Courts Costs against him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the Daying of the above attachment that then the said Day Court shall make restitution unto the said William King of all or such part as shall be so made appear to be undue as aforesaid or that he the said Robert Jenckins Henry will do the same for him &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the Several Goods and Chattels so as aforesaid attached and appraised to the value of Two pounds Six Shillings and five pence Curr. money of Maryland and Seven hundred and One pounds of tobacco be condemned as the proper goods and Chattels of the aforesaid William King toward satisfaction into the aforesaid Day Court the aforesaid Two pounds five Shillings and eleven pence Currant money of Maryland and Two hundred and Twenty Six pounds of tobacco as all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment aforesaid and that the said Day Court have thereof restitution according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.

Ed. William Rowley. Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Francis Brooks of Somerset County planter otherwise called Francis Brooks of said County if he should be found in his bailment and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing week the third Tuesday of June next being the first of June next at Seven hundred and forty Two to answer unto William Rowley of a plea that he tender unto him the Sum of Twenty pounds Curr. money of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c. and the same day is given to the said William here &c. At which day here came the said William Rowley by his Attorney and the Sheriff to wit John Handy Gent. now here returned that he had taken the said Francis Brooks whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the said William Rowley of the said plea as to him it was commanded.

And hereupon at the prayer of the said William Rowley the said Francis Brooks is adjudged to give special bail to the action of - Thereupon certain William Lane of Somerset County Gent. present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Francis Brooks Likewise the said Francis Brooks present herein Court in his proper person assumed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea of should be rendered for the same William Rowley against the same Francis Brooks or that he the same Francis Brooks should be therein convicted that then he the said Francis Brooks should pay and satisfy unto the said William Rowley the Judgment of the Court thereupon.
