Whereupon the afo^r Benjamin Warrington being present herein Court at the princi^p of the afo^r Charles Haymanis adjudged to give speciall baile to the action afo^r — Thereupon a certaine Willm^t English of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person understood for the said Benjamin Warrington Likewise the said Benjamin Warrington present herein Court as afo^r assumed upon himselfe that if it should happen that Judgement in the plena^r should be rendered for him in the afo^r Charles Hayman against the same Benjamin Warrington or that he the same Benjamin Warrington should be therein Convict that then he the said Benjamin Warrington should pay and satisfie unto the said Charles Hayman the Judgement of the Court thereupon or render his body in Execution of such Judgement to the prison of the sheriff of the County afo^r in satisfaction thereof or that he the same William English will do the same for him &c

And the afo^r Benjamin Warrington in his proper person comes and defends the force and Injury when & with that he cannot deny the action afo^r of the afo^r Charles Hayman nor but that he did affme upon himselfe in manner and forme as the afo^r Charles above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Charles by him by Occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Benjamin saith and acknowledge that the afo^r Charles hath sustained damages by Occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part opposed to two pounds nineteen shillings and 14 p^t money of Maryland and not more and because the afo^r Charles deniy not this but the same Allegation grants to be true prae^r Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his charges afo^r to him to be adju^rged &

Therefore by Consent of the parties afo^r it is Considered that the afo^r Charles Hayman recover against the afo^r Benjamin Warrington his Damages afo^r to the afo^r two pounds nineteen shillings 14 p^t money of Maryland By the same Benjamin in forme afo^r Acknowledged as also: Three hundred and nineteen pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges afo^r to the same Charles afo^r his request by the Court now here of the afo^r Consent of the parties afo^r adju^rged which certaine Damages in the whole amounts to two pounds nineteen shillings 14 p^t money of Maryland and: Three hundred and nineteen pounds of tobacco to the afo^r Benjamin in mercy &
