 seventeen shillings curr^t money of the Colony of Virginia of the value of one pound and fourteen shillings curr^t money of
 the province of Maryland for sundry articles properly chargeable in an account thereof hereto court brought
 may appear and so thereof demand bring the said Phillip in consideration thereof afterwards to the same day and year
 afo^r at Somerset County afo^r upon himself did assume and to the same John then and there faithfully promise that he
 the said Phillip the several sums of money afo^r unto the same John when there^r afterwards requested he would well and
 faithfully pay and content and altho^r the afo^r Phillip two pounds and two shillings curr^t money of Maryland part of
 the afo^r five pounds and sixteen shillings unto the same John he hath since paid and stat^r satisfied Nevertheless as to
 three pounds fourteen shillings of the said five pounds and sixteen shillings residue and the afo^r seventeen shillings
 Virginia currency of the value afo^r Phillip his promise and assumption afo^r little regarding but minding and
 fraudulently intending the same John in that part craftily and slyly to derive and deprive the afo^r several sums
 of three pounds and fourteen shillings curr^t money of Maryland and seventeen shillings Virginia currency to the
 value of or any part of either of the said sums unto the same John he hath not paid or contented altho^r the same to
 do the afo^r Phillip afterwards to the same day and year afo^r and often since that time at Somerset County afo^r
 was by the same John requested but the same to him to pay or content the said Phillip hath altogether refused and
 still doth refuse to the damage of the same John Ten pounds current money of Maryland and therof he brings
 Suit &c.
