 the province of Maryland for sundry articles properly chargeable in an account as by an account thereof herinto Court brought
 may appear and so thereof indebted being the said Phillip in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the same day and year
 of at Somerset County of upon himself did assume and to the same John then and there faithfully promise that he
 the said Phillip the several sums of money of unto the same John when thereof afterwards requested he would well and
 faithfully pay and content and altho: the said Phillip two pounds and two shillings Curr^t money of Maryland part of
 the said five pounds and sixteen shillings unto the same John he hath since paid and not satisfied Nevertheless as to
 three pounds fourteen shillings of the said five pounds and sixteen shillings residue and the said seventeen shillings
 Virginia Currency of the value of the said Phillip his promise and assumption of little regarding but minding and
 fraudulently intending the same John in that part craftily and suttely to deceive and defraud the said several sums
 of three pounds and fourteen shillings Curr^t money of Maryland and seventeen shillings Virginia Currency to the
 value of or any part of either of the said sums unto the same John he hath not paid or contented altho: the same to
 do the said Phillip afterwards to wit the same day and year of and often since that time at Somerset County aforesaid
 was by the same John requested but the same to him to pay or content the said Phillip hath altogether refused and
 still doth refuse to the damage of the same John Ten pounds Currant money of Maryland and thereof he brings
 Suit &c.
