AND the aforesaid Edmund Dickerson by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney comes and defend the forsaide Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid, of the aforesaid Robert Gadder nor can he say but that the writing Obligatory aforesaid is the deed of the same Edmund nor can he say but that he Owe the same Robert the aforesaid Seven pounds nine Shillings and Six pence in manner and form as the aforesaid Robert above against him hath declared &c.
