And whereupon the said Jacob by Francis Allen his Attorney complains that whereas the said William Willoughby James the tenth day of March Anno Domini seven hundred and forty at the County of Somerset aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Jacob in one pound six shillings and two pence Current money of Maryland and four hundred and thirty two pounds of tobacco for sundry properties chargeable in account as by account thereof ready herein Court to be produced may appear and being so thereof indebted the said William Willoughby James in consideration thereof the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon himself did assume and to the said Jacob then and there did faithfully promise that he the said William Willoughby James the said one pound six shillings and two pence and four hundred and thirty two pounds of tobacco to the said Jacob when he should be thereunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and content And altho' the said William Willoughby James one pound and
