 that the ^{re}d Jacob hath sustained Damages before by Occasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges
 by him about his suit in that part opposed to five shillings and five pence Current money of Maryland and for
 hundred and thirty two pounds of tobacco and not more and because the ^{re}d Jacob Hindman doth deny not
 this but the same allegation grants to be true privity Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with
 his Costs and Charges ^{re}d to him to be no more than £ 200

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Jacob Hindman Recover against the aforesaid
 William Willoughby James his damages aforesaid to the aforesaid five Shillings and five pence Current money
 of Maryland and four hundred and thirty two pounds of tobacco by the same William Willoughby James
 in form aforesaid Acknowledged as also Two hundred and Sixty Six pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges
 aforesaid to the same Jacob at his request by this Court now here adjudged and the aforesaid William in Money
 and afterward to wit the fifteenth day of June anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and forty Two
 the said William Willoughby James present herein Court in his proper person And whereupon the same William
 Willoughby James at the prayer of the aforesaid Jacob Hindman is committed into the custody or prison of the
 Sheriff of the County aforesaid there to remain while the said Jacob of his damages Costs and Charges aforesaid should
 be there of fully satisfied Whereupon the said Sheriff to wit John Hardy Geal present Person Court took charge of
 the said William Willoughby James accordingly etc

Summons was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he
 should take James Townsend Late of Somerset County planter if he

should be found in his County which did him should safe keep so that he might
 have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek
 the third Tuesday of June anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and forty Two to satisfy Benjamin
 Warrington of eight pounds Current money of Maryland and three hundred and eighty seven pounds of tobacco
 which to the same Benjamin in his Lordships County Court of Somerset before the Justices thereof at Dividing
 Creek were adjudged for his damage which he had by Occasion of a former promise and assumption to the
 same Benjamin by the aforesaid James made and not performed whereof he is Comit. etc

All which day here came the aforesaid Benjamin Warrington in his proper person and the Sheriff
