At which day here came the aforesaid Ephraim Waggaman by George Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Handy Gent now here returned that he had taken the said Littleton Townsend whose body here at this day he had ready to Satisfie the aforesaid Ephraim of the debt and Damages aforesaid, as aforesaid he was commanded &c

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Caleb Beavins late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Caleb Beavins of Somerset County in the province of Maryland planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty two to satisfie William Murray & Thomas Airey as well a certain Debt of Eleven pounds ten shilling and Eleven pence halfe penny current money of Maryland which the same William and Thomas in the same Court before the Justices thereof at dividing Creek recovered against him as of one hundred and ninety seven pounds of tobacco which to the same William and Thomas in the same Court were adjudged for the Damages which they had by Occasion of the Detention of that same Debt: whereof he is convicted &c

At which day here came the aforesaid William Murray and Thomas Airey by Francis Allen their attorney and the sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Handy Gent now here returned that he had taken the aforesaid Caleb Beavins whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfie the aforesaid William & Thomas of the debt and Damages aforesaid as aforesaid he was commanded &c
