At which day here came the aforesaid William Murray and Thomas Airey by Francis Allen their Attorney and the Sheriff to wit of Somerset County to wit John Handys Gent nowherereturned that he had taken the aforesaid Caleb Beavins whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfie the aforesaid William & Thomas of the debt and damage aforesaid he was commanded &c
