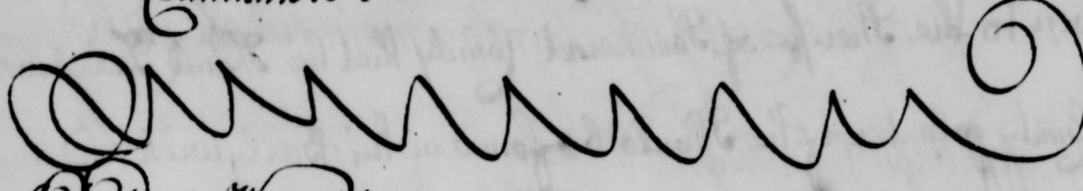


Body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June, then next following to satisfy Benjamin Warrington of five pounds Curr^t money of Maryland and five hundred and forty six pounds of tobacco a certain Debt as also Twenty two pounds of tobacco additional Costs which the said Paul Townsend together with James Townsend and Solomon Townsend before John Scott and William Lane Gentlemen Two of his said Lordships Justices of the said County Court on the Eighteenth day of June Anno Dom one thousand seven hundred and forty one Confessed Judgment unto the said Benjamin Warrington according to Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided whereof the said Paul is Convict &c

At which day here came the said Benjamin Warrington by Geo. Douglas his Attorney and the sheriffe of Somerset County to witt John Handy Gent. now here returned that he had taken the said Paul Townsend whose body here at this day he had ready to ^{satisfie} the said Benjamin of his Debt &c as to him it was Commanded &c
