 Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June and Term One thousand Seven hundred and  
 forty Two to Satisfie William Brereton of One pound Seventeen Shillings current money of Maryland and Seven hundred and  
 Sixty Two pounds of tobacco which to the Same William Brereton in his Lordships County Court of Somerset before the  
 Justice thereof at Dividing Creek were adjudged for his damages which he had by Breach of the non performance  
 of a certain promise and assumption to the Same William by the aforesaid Absolom made and not performed where  
 of he is Convict &c
