anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one confessed judgment unto the said Joseph Evans  
according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided whereof the said Nehemiah Dorman is convict  
and the same day is given to the said Joseph Evans

At which day here came the said Joseph Evans by his attorney and the Sheriff of  
Somerset County to witness John Randy gent. nowhere returned that he had taken the said Nehemiah Dorman whose  
Body herat this day he did ready to satisfy the said Joseph Evans of the debt and costs as to him it was  
commanded Somerset County by you Nehemiah Dorman Thomas Cary and George Marchant  
do confess Judgment to Joseph Evans for the sum of Sixty two pounds Current money and three hundred and  
nineteen pounds of tobacco which sum was confess to the said Joseph Evans by the said Nehemiah Dorman  
on the twelfth day of May 1741 before Henry Ballard and Thomas Gillige two of his Lordships Justices  
of the peace for the County of according to the Directions of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided  
the said Sixty two pounds Current money and three hundred and nineteen pounds of tobacco to be levied  
of your Bodys goods or Chattels Lands or tenements for the use of the said Joseph Evans in case the said  
Nehemiah Dorman shall not pay and satisfy to the said Joseph Evans the said Sixty two pounds Current  
money and three hundred and nineteen pounds of tobacco so as to consist with him with the additional costs  
thereon on the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of November next - Judgment Confest 19<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1742 before Thos Gillige
