At which day here come the said Joseph Ennalls by Francis Allen his Attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Sandys Gent. now here returned that he had taken the said Nehemiah Dorman whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the said Joseph Ennalls of the debt and Costs of as to him it was Comanded by Somerset County ss You Nehemiah Dorman Thomas Carey and George Mackrain do confess Judgment to Joseph Ennalls for the sum of sixty two pounds Curr: money and three hundred and nineteen pounds of tobacco which sum was Confest to the said Joseph Ennalls by the said Nehemiah Dorman on the twelfth day of May 1741 before Henry Ballard and Thomas Gilliffe two of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County of according to the Directions of <sup>the</sup> Act of Assembly in such case made and provided the said sixty two pounds Curr: money and three hundred and nineteen pounds of tobacco to be Levied of your body Goods or Chattles Lands or tenements for the use of the said Joseph Ennalls in case the said Nehemiah Dorman shall not pay and satisfy to the said Joseph Ennalls the said sixty two pounds Curr: money and three hundred and nineteen pounds of tobacco so as of Confest by him with the additionall Costs thereon on the 10 day of November next Judgment Confest 17 day of May 1742 before Tho: Gilliffe
