Cost the said sum of four pounds in bills of Credit curr. money and two hundred and forty eight pounds of tobacco to be levied of your bodies goods or Chattels Lands and tenements for the use of the said Joseph Ermills in case the said John Evans shall not pay and satisfy to the said Joseph Ermills the said sum of four pounds in bills of Credit curr. money and two hundred and forty eight pounds of tobacco so as to be recovered against him with the additional costs thereon on the tenth day of November next before us this 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1742 —
