

All which day here came the ap<sup>d</sup> Joseph Enalls by Francis Allen his Attorney and the sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Handy Gent. now here returned that he had taken the ap<sup>d</sup> John Evans whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the ap<sup>d</sup> Joseph Enalls of the Damages ap<sup>d</sup> to him it was Comanded &c

You John Evans, Stephen Wright and John Evans Jur<sup>ors</sup> doe Give Judgment to Joseph Enalls for the sum of four pounds in bills of Credit Curr. money and two hundred and fifty Eight pounds of tobacco which sum was Recovered by the said Joseph Enalls against the said John Evans on the <sup>One thousand Seven hundred and forty One</sup> Sixteenth day of June ... in the County

Court the said sum of four pounds in bills of Credit Curr. money and two hundred and fifty Eight pounds of tobacco to be levied of your bodies goods or Chattles Lands and tenements for the use of the said Joseph Enalls in Case the said John Evans shall not pay and satisfy to the said Joseph Enalls the said sum of four pounds in bills of Credit Curr. money and two hundred and fifty Eight pounds of tobacco as ap<sup>d</sup> Recovered against him with <sup>the</sup> additionall Costs thereon on the tenth day of November Judgment Confest before us this 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1742 — Geo. Mr. Thomas Chaise ... } Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should Take Thomas Chaise Clerk of Somerset County (and otherwise called Thomas Chaise of Somerset County in many kindes) if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him should safe Keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty two to satisfy Onorio Rosalini as well a certain debt of fifty pounds sterling which the same Onorio Rosalini in the same Court before the Justices thereof at Dividing Creek recovered against him as of three hundred and Eighty two pounds of tobacco which to the same Onorio in the same Court were adjudged for his Damages which he had by Occasion of the Detention of that same debt whereof he is Convict &c

All which day here came the ap<sup>d</sup> Onorio Rosalina by Robert Jenkins Henry his Attorney and the sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Handy Gent. now here returned that he had taken the ap<sup>d</sup> Thomas Chaise whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the ap<sup>d</sup> Onorio Rosalina of the debt and Damages ap<sup>d</sup> to him it was Comanded &c
