

You Thomas Chaise John Tunstall and Patrick Allison all of Somerset County doe Confess Judgment to Onorio Rosalini for the sum of fifty pounds sterling and three hundred and Eighty two pounds of tobacco which sum was recovered by the said Onorio Rosalini against Thomas Chaise on the third Tuesday of Nov^r Seventeen hundred and forty one in Somerset County Court the said Fifty pounds sterling and three hundred and Eighty two pounds of tobacco to be Levied of your bodies Goods or Cattle Lands or tenements for the use of the said Onorio Rosalini In Case the said Thomas Chaise shall not pay and satisfy to the said Onorio Rosalini the said sum of fifty pounds sterling and three hundred and Eighty two pounds of tobacco to so as a^d recovered against him with the additionall Costs thereon on the tenth day of November next the above Judgment Confessed the 8th of June 1742 before me — Lewis Gale

Command was given to the sheriffe of Somerset County that he should Take Heber Whittingham late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini thousand seven hundred and forty two to satisfy David Wilson of twenty pounds thirteen shillings and one penny Curr^t money and four hundred and fourteen pounds of tobacco which the same David Wilson in the same Court before the Justices thereof at dividing Creek were adjudged for his Damages which he had by Occasion of a certain promise and assumption to the same David by the a^d Heber made and not performed whereof he is Convict &c

At which day here came the a^d David Wilson by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney and the sheriffe of Somerset County with John Handy Gent^l now here returned that he had taken the a^d Heber Whittingham whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the a^d David Wilson of the Damages a^d as to him it was Commanded &c
