acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord  
Proprietary of maryland in the full and just sum of five pounds Court money of the said  
provinces of their bodys goods or Chattles Lands or tenements severally to be made and Levied  
to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors. If It happen that the said  
Archibald Mc Neal doe not pay and satisfis unto the sheriffs of this County of for the time  
being fifty Shillings Court money of the province of yearly and for every year he shall keep  
such Ordinary or house of Entertainment aforesaid.

Likewise the said Archibald Mc Neal with Robert Lyvans and William Beavins  
his securitys aforesaid all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves  
Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary in forty pounds Court money of  
maryland of their bodys goods or Chattles Lands or tenements severally to be made and  
Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors. . . If It happen that the said  
Archibald Mc Neal doe not keep good rules and Orders and do suffer Idle loose and disorderly  
persons to tipple Games or Comitt disorders or other Irregularities in his Ordinary or house  
of Entertainment dureing the time that he shall keep the same contrary to the true Intent  
and meaning of the act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.
