George Twilley } late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailly with and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next. One Thousand Seven hundred and forty Two to answer unto Richard Barker of a plea of trespass upon the fact. and the Same day is given to the said Richard Barker &c

At which day here came the aforesaid Richard Barker by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney and the Sheriff to wit John Hardy Gentleman at the Same day now here returned that he had taken the aforesaid George Twilley whose body he had here ready to answer the aforesaid Richard Barker, of his aforesaid plea as to him it was Commanded - And the aforesaid Richard Barker complained of the aforesaid George Twilley in the aforesaid plea in form following - Somerset s. George Twilley late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto Richard Barker of a plea of trespass upon the fact - -

And whereupon the Same Richard by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney complains that Whereas the aforesaid George the sixteenth day of October in the year of Our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and forty and one at Somerset County was indebted unto the Same Richard in the Sum of three pounds fifteen Shillings and three pence farthing Current money of the province of Maryland for sundry articles properly charged in an account as by an account there of hereto Court brought may appear and so thereof indebted being the aforesaid George afterwards to wit the same day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid in consideration thereof upon himself assumed and to the Same Richard then and there faithfully promise that he the said George the Sum of Money aforesaid unto the Same Richard when thereto afterwards requested he would well and faithfully pay and Content Never the less the said George his promise and assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made Little regarding but invidious and fraudulently intending the Same Richard in that part rashly and Publicly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid Sum of three pounds fifteen Shillings and three pence farthing or any part thereof unto the Same Richard (altho' the Same to do the said George afterwards to wit the Same day and year aforesaid and after his Price at Somerset County aforesaid by the Same Richard was requested hath not paid or him for the Same in any sort Contented but the Same to him to pay or Content either to hath
