

said Ignatius likewise the same Ignatius Kaddock present here in Court as aforesaid affirmed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea aforesaid should be rendered for the same Henry against the same Ignatius, or that he the same Ignatius should be therein convicted that then he the said Ignatius should pay and satisfy unto the same Henry Lower the Judgment of the Court thereupon or render his body to the prison of the Sheriff of the County aforesaid in satisfaction thereof or that he the said James Knight will do the same for him &c.

And here upon the said Henry declared against the aforesaid Ignatius in the plea aforesaid in form following -
 Somerset p. Ignatius Kaddock Late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Ignatius Kaddock of Somerset County planter was Summoned to answer unto Henry Lower of a plea that he render unto him One thousand One hundred and Twenty Six pounds of tobacco which to him he Owes and lawfully detains &c.

And Whereupon the same Henry by William Perbuckle his attorney saith that whereas the said Ignatius the Twenty seventh day of December anno Domini. Seventeen hundred and thirty nine at Somerset County by his Certain Bill Obligatory which the same Henry with the Seal of the said Ignatius Sealed herewith Court brings whereof is the same day and year aforesaid bound himself his heirs Executors and Admin. in the aforesaid Sum of One thousand One hundred and Twenty Six pounds of tobacco for the payment of five hundred and Sixty three pounds of tobacco to the aforesaid Henry and his assigns on or before the Twenty fifth day of December next Ensuing the date of the said Bill and the aforesaid Ignatius the aforesaid Tobacco upon the Twenty fifth day of December to the same Henry hath not paid which to him he Ought to have paid according to the form and Effect of the said Bill by which action answers to the said Henry to have and require of the aforesaid Ignatius the aforesaid One thousand One hundred and Twenty Six pounds of tobacco Nevertheless the said Ignatius altho. often Required the aforesaid tobacco the same Henry hath not satisfied nor paid but the same to pay hitherto altogether hath denied and still doth deny Whereupon the same Henry saith he is Damified and Damage hath to the value of Twenty pounds Current money of Maryland and thereof brings -

And whereupon the said Ignatius Kaddock in his proper person comes and defends the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Henry Lower nor can he say but the writing aforesaid is his debt nor can he say but that he Owes the same Henry the aforesaid One thousand One hundred and Twenty Six pounds of tobacco in manner and form as the said Henry above against him hath declared &c.

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Henry Lower Recover against the aforesaid Ignatius Kaddock his debt aforesaid and his Damages by occasion of the detention of the same debt to
