Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should
take David Hudson Late of Somerset County planter if he should be found
in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body be-

fore the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwiding Creek the third Tuesday of
June anno. Dom. One thousand Seven hundred and forty One to answer unto James Stephen Bredell of plea of
her pass upon the Case &c and the Same day is given to the aforesaid James Stephen here &c.

All which day here came again the aforesaid James Stephen Bredell by William Arbuckle his
attorney and the Sheriff to with John Hardy Gent. now here Returned that he had Taken the aforesaid David
Hudson whose body here at this day he had ready to answer unto the aforesaid James Stephen Bredell of the afo
plea as to him it was Commanded

Whereupon the said David Hudson puts in his place
George Douglas Gentleman attorney at Law against the aforesaid James Stephen Bredell of the aforesaid plea

And thereupon at the Request of the parties aforesaid day is to them now here given until next Court to
be held at Dwiding Creek in and for the County aforesaid the third Tuesday of August then next following in the same
Place as at present Saving to the parties aforesaid &c

All which day here came again the parties aforesaid by their attorneys aforesaid and hereupon
the said James Stephen complained of the aforesaid David in the plea aforesaid in form following vizt.

Somerset s. David Hudson Late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto James
Stephen Bredell of plea of her pass upon the Case &c

And Whereupon the said James Stephen by William Arbuckle his attorney complains that whereas
the said James is an honest and peaceable Subject of our Lord the King That now is and as an honest and peaceable
Subject of the said King and Progenitors from his nativity neither to himself has Behaved and Governed for
and clear of any forceable Entry or Breach of the peace of our said Lord the King or the Right honorable the
Lord Proprietary never the less the said David not Ignorant of the premises but plotting and Maliciously
Intending
