have her body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek
the Third Tuesday of August anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and forty Two to answer unto his Lordship
and concerning of the presentment aforesaid &c.

And now to wit the ^{seventeenth} day of August anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and forty Two at a Court
then held at dividing Creek before his Lordship's Justices came the aforesaid Sarah Howchen in her proper
person and forasmuch as it doth appear to the Court ^{here} this Inspection that the aforesaid Sarah Howchen
had done what in her Day to comply with the Indenture of the aforesaid Levin Bayton in Learning him
his trade &c. Wherefore it is considered that the aforesaid Sarah Howchen of the presentment aforesaid
be quiet and goe thereof without day &c. -- paying the Several Officers their fees due by means of the
premises aforesaid &c.
