Searched and Recognizance and pray, that he may be permitted to keep an Ordinary or house of Entertainment at his house in
Snow Hill Town, in Somerset County, for the use and convenience of the Inhabitants Traveller and Strangers, as to them severally,
Shall seem meet, which is by the Court here unto him granted, requiring security for to comply with the act of
Assembly in such case made and provided vs.

Whereupon the said David Murray with James Martin and Samuel Hopkins of Somerset
County Gentlemen his security all present here unto Court in their proper persons, acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his
Lordship, the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland, in the full and just sum off five pounds.
Current money of said province, of their body, goods, or chattels, Lands, or tenements, severally to be made and levied
to the use of his said Lordships heirs and Successors. If it happen that the said David Murray doe not pay
and satisfy unto the Sheriff of the County aforesaid for the sum being fifty Shillings Current money of the province
aforesaid, yearly and every year he shall keep such Ordinary or house of Entertainment as aforesaid.

Likewise the same David Murray with James Martin and Samuel Hopkins his security as aforesaid
all present hereunto Court in their proper persons as aforesaid, acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his said Lordship the
Lord Proprietary in forty pounds Current money of Maryland, of their body, goods, or chattels, Lands, or tenements severally
to be made and levied, to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors. If it happen that the said David
