And the aforesaid James Timmons in his proper person Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c and Saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins nor can he say but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins above against him hath Complain'd and as to the Damage of the same Samuel by him by Breach of the promise in that part Sustained the same James Saith and acknowledged yet that the aforesaid Samuel has Sustained Damages by Breach of the promise beyond his Cost and Charges by him about his Suit in that part apposed to Six pounds Sixteen Shillings and four pence Current money of Maryland and not more and because the aforesaid Samuel deny not him but the same allegation grants to be true pray Judgment and those Damages above acknowledged together with his Cost and Charges aforesaid to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid It is considered that the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins Recover against the aforesaid James Timmons his Damages aforesaid to the aforesaid Six pounds Sixteen Shillings and four pence Current money of Maryland by the same James in form aforesaid acknowledged as also Three hundred and Sixty four pounds of Tobacco for his Cost and Charges aforesaid to the same Samuel at his request by the Court now here ~~of the Court~~ of the parties aforesaid Adjudged which certain Damages in the whole amount to Six pounds Sixteen Shillings and four pence Current money of Maryland and Three hundred and Sixty four pounds of Tobacco and the aforesaid James in Mercy &c and afterwards to wit the same Seventeenth day of August ~~and~~ One thousand Seven hundred and forty Two the aforesaid James Timmons being present herein Court in his proper person and Whereupon the same James at the prayer of the aforesaid of the aforesaid Samuel by his attorney ^{Samuel} is committed to the prison of the Sheriff of the County aforesaid thereto remain until the aforesaid of the Damages ^{Samuel} ~~of~~ should be fully Satisfied &c

— You James Timmons John Timmons and John Alderson do Coufess Judgment unto Samuel Hopkins for the Sum of Six pounds Sixteen Shillings and four pence Current money of Maryland and Three hundred and Sixty four pounds of Tobacco which Sum was Recovered by the said Samuel Hopkins against James Timmons on the Seventeenth day of August in the County Court the said Six pounds Sixteen Shillings and four pence Current money of Maryland and Three hundred and Sixty four pounds of Tobacco to be Levied of your Bodies goods or Chattels Land or Tenements for the Use of the said Samuel Hopkins in Case James Timmons shall not pay and Satisfie unto the said Samuel Hopkins the said Six pounds Sixteen Shillings and four pence Current money of Maryland and Three hundred and Sixty four pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid Recovered against ^{him} with the additional Cost thereon on the Tenth day of November next Taken before us the 20. day of August.
