Seven Shillings Current money to be paid unto the said Levi Bredele Israhel Bredele and David Bredele their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns to the which payment well and Truly to be made and done we bind Our selves Our heirs either Our heirs Executors and assigns for the whole and in the whole jointly by these presents Sealed with Our Seals and dated this 16th day of August Anno Domini 1742.

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such that whereas the Comptroller Generall hath Transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of Israhel Bredele decd. wherein it is found that there is balance due unto the above said Bregham the Sum of One hundred and Thirty nine pounds three Shillings and Six pence Curr^t money of Maryland. Therefore if the above said James Stephen Bredele Race Clark and Samuel Howells them or any of them their heirs Executors or Administrators Shall well and Truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above said Bregham the aforesaid Sum of One hundred and Thirty nine pounds three Shillings and Six pence in equal parts and portions according to act of assembly when they Shall arrive at full age to receive the Same &c. Then the Obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue &c.

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such that whereas the Comptroller Generall hath Transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of Samuel Melson decd. wherein it is found that there is Balance due to the above said Isabel Melson the Sum of four pounds Seventeen Shillings and One farthing Current money Therefore if the above said Isaac Cooper Mitchell Dashiell and Thomas Gilliffe or any or either of them or any of their heirs Executors or assigns Shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above said Isabel Melson the Sum of four pounds Seventeen Shillings and One half penny Current money of Maryland according to act of assembly and the deceaseds will when she shall arrive at full age to receive the Same &c. Then the above Obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue &c.
