I'm paid for and by Occasion of the premises aforesaid where of in form aforesaid he is bound to Thirty shillings Current money of Maryland and that the said Cornelius Ready be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine afo.

Whereupon the said Cornelius Ready is Ordered by the Court here to give Security for the payment of the several ^{and other persons} fees due on the Information aforesaid Theron upon a certain Bryan Ready of Somerset County planter present here in Court in his proper person undertook for the same Cornelius Ready to pay the several Officers and other persons fees due on the Information aforesaid by means of the premises aforesaid in case the said Cornelius Ready doth not pay the same &c.

His Lordship } And now to wit the third Tuesday of August being the nineteenth day of the same month
Hugh Rimor. } and. Dow. One thousand seven hundred and forty at about three held before his Lordship
Justices at dividing Creek a certain Hugh Rimor altho' solemnly called according to a certain Recognizance by him in that part before acknowledged for his appearance here at this day to give Evidence on behalf of his said Lordship against a certain Ann Cook and Patrick Connelly came not.

Thereupon the Recognizance aforesaid of the said Hugh Rimor is by the Court here Respited until next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County afo the third Tuesday of November then next following in the same State as at present &c. All which day here came the said Hugh Rimor in his proper person and prays that his appearance may be leaved, and he discharged from the Recognizance aforesaid.

Thereupon the said Hugh Rimor's appearance is Recorded and he from the Recognizance afo is discharged

Whereupon the said Hugh Rimor is Ordered by the Court here to give new Recognizance in Ten pounds Current money for his appearance at next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid the third Tuesday of March then next following to give Evidence on behalf of his Lordship against the said Ann Cook and Patrick Connelly &c.

Thereupon the said Hugh Rimor present here in Court in his proper person acknowledged himself indebted ^{unto his said Lordship} in ten pounds Current money of Maryland of his body goods or Chattels Lands or tenements to be made and Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors. If it happen that the said Hugh Rimor doe not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next following and doe not then and there give such Evidence as he shall know against the said Ann Cook on Suspicion of Felony, and against the said Patrick Connelly for the receiving of stolen Money knowing the same to be stolen and doe depart the same Court without Leave &c.

His Lordship - } Robert Givans and Ann Richardson of Somerset County planters came here into Court
Robert Givans & } in their proper persons according to a certain Recognizance by them in that part first acknowledged
Ann Richardson. } and prays that their appearance may be leaved and they from their Recognizance ^{afo} accordingly discharged. Thereupon the said Robert Givans and Ann Richardson's appearances are Recorded and they from their Recognizances afo are discharged.

Whereupon the said Robert Givans and Ann Richardson are Ordered to give Recognizance in Ten
