and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be
held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty
to answer unto Francis Lee of a plea of trespass upon the case &c and the same day is given to the said Francis
Lee 4^o.

At which day here came the aforesaid Francis Lee by Robert Jenchins Henry his attorney and the
Sheriff to wit John Henry gent now here returned that he had taken the aforesaid John Waller whose
body hereat this day he has ready to answer the aforesaid plea as to him it was commanded.

Whereupon the aforesaid John Waller puts in his place Francis Allen gent Attorney at Law
against the aforesaid Francis Lee of the aforesaid plea. 4^o.

And thereupon at the request of the parties a day is to them now here given until next Court
to be held at Bridgwater the third Tuesday of November then next following in the same state as at present
serving to the parties aforesaid 4^o.

All which day here came againe the aforesaid John Waller by his attorney aforesaid and the
aforesaid Francis Lee altho solemnly called came not nor is his writt aforesaid against the aforesaid John Waller
further prosecute.

Therefore he and his pledges of Prosecuting are in mercy and lett the said Francis
Lee hence pledges &c and that the aforesaid John Waller goe thereof without day also it is considered that the
aforesaid John Waller recover against the aforesaid Francis Lee his damages by Quasion of the sume for
161 pounds of tobacco to the same John by direction of the Justices here at his request
for his Costs and Charges in that part sustained according to the form of His Statute in such Case Lately made and provided
by the Court here adjudged.
