Therefore Others of those standing by hereunto sealed by the Sheriff of this County aforesaid and at the Request of the aforesaid Francis Harper and Mary his wife and by the Command of the said Justices are newly put on whose Names to his Panel within written are affixed according to the form of the Statute in such Case made and provided which said Juries so newly put on to wit Dawson Hough Thomas Mitchell Isaac Boston and Robert Gwars being called Likewise came who to say the truth of the premises together with the other Juries aforesaid first in panelled and sworn being elected byes and sworn and the same Juries of their Verdict Hereupon to say by the Court here charged and from the Bar of this Court of their Verdict of and upon the premises aforesaid to render among themselves together to come did depart and afterward to the Bar for their Verdict in this part to render returnee And the aforesaid Francis Harper and Mary his wife solemnly <sup>alio.</sup> called came not nor is their will aforesaid against the aforesaid James Knight further prosecute.

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Francis Harper and Mary his wife and their pledges of proceeding to wit John Doe and Richard Roe are in Mercy and that the aforesaid James Knight Tenant of the aforesaid Aaron Gordie goeth here of without day &c. Also it is considered that the aforesaid James Knight recover against the aforesaid Francis Harper and Mary his wife seven <sup>lunngd</sup> and fifty six pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his Defence in that part In substance to the same James Knight by the Court here of his agent adjudged according to the form of the Statute in such Case Lately made and provided and that the aforesaid James Knight have hereof payment &c.

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Joseph Mawlester late of Somerset County Gentleman if he should be found in his baileywick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held

at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of August Anno Dom one thousand seven hundred and thirtynine to answer unto James Martin of a plea of trespass upon the case &c and the same day is given to the aforesaid James here &c. All which day here came the aforesaid James Martin by George Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff now here returned at the same day that he had taken the aforesaid Joseph Mawlester and him detained in his prison so sick and languishing that his body here at this day he could not have been

Thereupon it is again commanded the aforesaid Sheriff that he or his under Sheriff should be before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November then next following coming with them the aforesaid Joseph Mawlester whether he be in health or Insane to answer the aforesaid James Martin of the aforesaid plead. and the same day is given to the aforesaid James Martin here &c.

All which day here came <sup>again</sup> the aforesaid James Martin by his attorney aforesaid and the same Sheriff at the same day here returned that he had here ready the body of the aforesaid Joseph Mawlester to answer the aforesaid James Martin of the aforesaid plea as to him it was commanded

And hereupon the said Joseph Mawlester puts in his place Robert Jenkins Henry Gentleman attorney at Law against the aforesaid James Martin of the aforesaid Plea

Whereupon at the request of the parties aforesaid day is to them now here given until next Court to be held at Dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid third Tuesday of March then next following in the same state as at present saving to the parties aforesaid

All which day here came again the parties aforesaid by their attorneys aforesaid
