All which day here came the afo^d Robert Goddes and Susanna his wife in their proper persons and the sheriff to wit John Handly gent now here returned that he had taken the afo^d Francis Allen whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the afo^d Robert & Susanna of their costs afo^d as to him it was commanded

Command was given to the sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Francis Tate late of Somerset County Schoolmaster if he should be found in his Bailewick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November. Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty to satisfy William Jones of Nascongo of two pounds fifteen shillings and seven pence half penny curr^t money of Maryland and three hundred and fifty two pounds of tobacco which to the same William Jones in the same Court before the Justices thereof at dividing Creek were adjudged for his damages which he had by Occasion of a certain promise and assumption to the same William by the afo^d Francis made and not performed whereof he is convicted and the same day is given to the afo^d William here ^{to}

All which day here comes the afo^d William Jones by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney and the sheriff to wit John Handly gent now here returned that he had taken the afo^d Francis Tate whose body hereat this day he had ready to satisfy the afo^d William Jones of his damages afo^d as to him it was commanded
