Command was given to the sheriffe of Somerset County that he should take Michael Holland late of Somerset County Mariner if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November Anno Dom one thousand seven hundred and forty to answer unto William Whittington of a plea of trespass upon the case &c. And the same day is given to the afo^r William here &c. And the said William Whittington complained against the afo^r Michael Holland in the plea afo^r in form following — Somerset County s^t Michael Holland late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer William Whittington of a plea of trespass upon the case

And Whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his Attorney complains that whereas the said Michael the Eleventh day of May Anno Dom seventeen hundred and forty at Somerset County afo^r within the Jur^{is} of this Court was Debted unto the said William in four hundred twenty and nine pounds of tobacco for sundry properly chargeable in Acc^t as by Ac^t thereof here in Court ready to be produced may appear and being so thereof Debted the said Michael in consideration thereof the day and year afo^r at the County afo^r upon himself did assume and to the said William then and there did faithfully promise that he the said Michael the afo^r four hundred twenty and nine pounds of tobacco to the said William when he should be there to requested well and faithfully he would pay and content Nevertheless the said Michael his promise and assumption afo^r in forme afo^r made nothing regarding but plotting and fraudulently intending the said William in that part craftily and Subtily to deceive and defraud the said four hundred twenty and nine pounds of tobacco to the said William altho: the same to do the said Michael on the afo^r Eleventh day of may in the year afo^r and often afterwards at Somerset County afo^r he was thereunto requested hath not paid or contented but the same to him hitherto to pay or content hath refused and still doth refuse and deny to the damage of the said William of Eight hundred pounds of tobacco and thereupon he brings Suit &c.
