Likewise the same Wonney Maclemmy with the a^s Solomon Long and Whittington King his Securitys a^s all present here in Court in their proper persons Acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord proprietary in forty pounds Current money of Maryland of their bodys goods or Chattles Lands or tenements severally to be made and Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors. If it happen that the said Wonney Maclemmy doe not keep good rules and Orders and do suffer Idle loose or disorderly persons to tipple game or Commit disorders or other Irregularities in his Ordinary or house of Entertainment during the time that he shall keep the same contrary to the true intent and meaning of the Act of Assembly in such Case provided &c

John Denton sen^r appointed Overseer of the Roads in Coromack hundred for the Ensuing Year in stead of John Sheldon &c

James Weatherly appointed Overseer of the Roads in Nantuxie hundred for the Ensuing Year from Rawastio Mill to Baron Creek Mill and from the head of Little Creek Over into the main Road that Leads from James Gwans's to the Chapple, and from thence up to the Chapple at Spring Hill &c

Ambros Willett appointed Overseer of the Road from The Muddy Branch at the Corner of Lope's Old plantation Down to Littleton's Creek and Over the Runn of said Creek to a tree to be marked by Be^r William Lane &c
