Thereupon it is Commaided the Sheriff that he should Take the said Rose Roach iff^{ts}. to answer &c. And afterwards to wit the same seventeenth day of March and Year abovesd at about then held before his Lordships Justices at dividng Creek in and for the County afo^{rs}. Came the aforesaid Rose Roach in her proper person, and had a hearing of the Information aforesaid, and saith that she cannot deny, but that she is Guilty of the premises afo^{rs}. in the Information aforesaid Specified, above upon her Imposed, in manner and form as by the Information afo^{rs} above against her supposed

Whereupon all and Singular the premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood -

And forasmuch as it appeareth to the Court here, that by Law there is due to the County of Somerset Seven years service from such person, or persons, that are Guilty of such Inordinate Reputation as aforesaid &c.

Wherefore it is considered by the Justices here that the afo^{rs} Rose Roach return home to Mistris Mary Fountain's service, and that she serve her said Mistris, four full months, to commence at the end of her now servitude which is adjudged by the Court here for full Satisfaction, for damage, trouble, Loss of time, and Expences her said Mistris had, and was at, at the time of her going in, in Child bed &c.

Whereupon the said Mary Fountain is Ordered by the Court here to Return the said Rose Roach to the County Court of Somerset, or Sheriff of the County, to make Satisfaction to the County afo^{rs}, for the afo^{rs} Seven years service and the severall Officers afo^{rs} their fees due by means of the premises afo^{rs}.

Thereupon the said Mary Fountain present here in Court in her proper person undertook to Deliver up the afo^{rs} Rose Roach at the Expiration of her servitude as afo^{rs} unto the County Court of Somerset or the Sher. of the County &c.

His Lordship - } AND now to wit the seventeenth day of March and Year One thousand seven hundred and forty at about then held at dividng Creek in and for the County aforesaid before his Lordship, Justices Came a certain Henry Walston in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance by him and his Security in this part before acknowledged and prays that his appearance may be Recorded and he and his Security discharged &c. Thereupon the said Henry Walston's appearance is Recorded and he and his Security accordingly discharged &c.

Whereupon the said Henry Walston is Ordered to give new Recognizance for his appearance before his Lordships Justices at the next Court to be held at dividng Creek the third Tuesday of June then next following, to answer his Committing of Fornication with a certain Mary Miles &c.

Thereupon the said Henry Walston with Robert King of Somerset County Esq^r his Security both present here in Court in their proper persons, acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in Twenty pounds Curr^t. money of their body's Goods or Chattels Land or Tenements severally
