Thereupon it is Commanded the Sheriff that he Should Take the said Rose Roach off to answer
her and afterwards to witt the same seventeenth day of March and Year abovevntil at about then held before his Lordship,
Justices at dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid came the aforesaid Rose Roach in her proper person, and had a hearing
of the Information aforesaid, and saith that she Laynot downe, but that she is Guilty of the premises aforesaid, in the Information
aforesaid Specified, above upon her Imposed, in manner and form as by the Information aforesaid above against her supposed

Whereupon all and Singular the premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood -

And forasmuch as it appeareth to the Court here, that by Law there is due to the County of Somerset Seven
years Service from such person, or persons, that are Guilty of such Inordinate Reputation as aforesaid Gen-

Wherefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the aforesaid Rose Roach return home
to Mistris Mary Mountainis service, and that she serve her said Mistris four full months, to commence
at the end of her now Servitude which is adjudged by the Court here for full Satisfaction, for damage, trou-
ble, Loss of time, and Expences her said Mistris had, and was at, at the time of her lying in, in Field Bedd the

Whereupon the said Mary Mountain is Ordered by the Court here to Return the said Rose Roach to the
County Court of Somerset, or Sheriff of the County, to make Satisfaction to the County aforesaid for the aforesaid Seven years
Service and the severall Officers Officers their fees due by means of the premises aforesaid

Thereupon the said Mary Mountain present here in Court in her proper person undertooke to
Deliver up the aforesaid Rose Roach at the Expiration of her servitude as aforesaid unto the County Court of Somerset or
the Sheriff of the County ther

His Lordship. { And now to witt the seventeenth day of March anno Domini One thousand seven hundred
and forty at about then held at dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid before his
Henry Walston. Lordship, Justices came a certain Henry Walston in his proper person according to a certain
Recognizance by him and his security in this part before acknowledged and prayes that his appearance may be
Recorded and he and his security discharged &c. Thereupon the said Henry Walstons appearance is
Recorded and he and his security accordingly discharged &c.

Whereupon the said Henry Walstons is Ordered to give new Recognizance for his
appearance before his Lordships Justices at the next Court to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of
June then next following to answer his Committing of fornication with a certain Mary Miles ^{his security} &c

Thereupon the said Henry Walston with Robert King of Somerset County Esq; both present here
in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordships the Right Honourable
the Lord Proprietary in Twenty pounds curr. money of their body's Good. or Chally Lands or tenements severally
to
