The same . . . Somerset. Be it Remembred that Robert Jenckins Henry Gent. Attorney of the right —  
Patrick Connely Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is who for the same Lord Proprietary in this  
part doth come here into the County Court of the same Lord Proprietary held for Somerset County  
as to witt at dividing Creek in the same County the nineteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand  
seven hundred and forty before Robert King Esq; and his Associates the said Lord Proprietary his Justices of the  
same County Court and for the same Lord Proprietary doth give the Court here to understand and be Informed that —  
whereas a certain Ann Clark late of Stepney parish in the said County of Somerset Spinster the Ninth day of June in  
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty as with force and arms at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid  
one pound and four shillings in Gold currency of the province of Maryland and twelve shillings and six pence current  
money of the province aforesaid in bills of credit of the goods and chattles of a certain Hugh Rimmer then and there feloniously  
did steal take and bear away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and government  
and the same Attorney of the said Lord Proprietary doth give the Court here further to understand and be Informed that  
Patrick Connely late of Somerset parish in the said County of Somerset Teller maker after the twelfth day of February one thousand  
seven hundred and two and after the felony aforesaid in form aforesaid done and perpetrated knowing the aforesaid Ann Clark the felony  
aforesaid to have done and perpetrated and also knowing the aforesaid one pound and four shillings in Gold currency  
of the province of Maryland and twelve shillings and six pence current money of the province aforesaid in bills of credit to have  
been so as aforesaid Stolen on the tenth day of June in the year aforesaid at Stepney parish aforesaid in the County of Somerset the said  
Patrick Connely the severall sum of one pound and four shillings in Gold currency aforesaid and twelve shillings and six pence  
current money of the province aforesaid in bills of credit knowing the same to be stolen in manner and form aforesaid from the said  
Ann Clark Feloniously did receive to the Evill and pernicious Example of all Others in such case offending contrary  
to the peace of the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and government and against the  
form of the statute in such case lately made and provided &c Whereupon the same Attorney of the same Lord Proprietary  
for the same Lord Proprietary prays the Notice of the Court here in the premises and that due process of Law in this part  
against the same Patrick Connely made to answer unto the same Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises &c

Whereupon it is Commanded the Sheriff of the County aforesaid that he should take the said Patrick if he  
be answerable and afterwards lie with the day and year above said before his Lordships Justices at a Court then held  
at dividing Creek before the aforesaid Patrick Connely in his proper person according to aetiam Recoginiance by him  
and his security in that part first acknowledged and pray that his appearance may be recorded and he and his security  
discharged. Whereupon the said Patrick Connelys appearance is recorded and he and his security accordingly  
discharged from the Recoginiance aforesaid &c. Whereupon on the same day and year above said the said  
Patrick Connely is ordered by the Court here to give new Recoginiance in fifty pounds Current money of the  
Province aforesaid with two securities in Twenty five pounds Current money each for his the said Patrick Connely,  
good behaviour and appearance at next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid the third  
Tuesday of August then next following to answer the Information aforesaid &c

Whereupon the said Patrick Connely with a certain William Dennis of Somerset County planter and  
James Anderson of the same place planter his security all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged
