 Walton Orphan as afo<sup>r</sup> their heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to the which payment  
 well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves our and either of our heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> and Adm<sup>rs</sup>  
 for the whole and in the whole jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our  
 seals and dated this 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1740.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the Com<sup>rs</sup> of the said Court  
 hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the estate of Fisher Walton dec<sup>d</sup> wherein it is  
 found that there is Balance due to the abovesaid Orphan the sum of Sixty seven pounds  
 twelve Shillings and a penny half penny Curr<sup>t</sup> money therefore if the abovesaid Sam<sup>l</sup> Gillett Wm  
 Walton Moses Mills and Robert Stephenson they or either of their heirs Executors or Administrators  
 shall and do well and truly pay unto the abovesaid Orphan the sum of Sixty seven pounds  
 twelve Shillings and a penny half penny Curr<sup>t</sup> money according to Act of Assembly and the dec<sup>d</sup>  
 will when they shall arriv<sup>e</sup> at full age to receive the same & then the above obligation to be  
 void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue &c.
