And the said John Rowby says that he by anything by the said Mary in her plea precluded from having and maintaining his action against her ought not to be precluded because he says that the said John Lammore did not pay to the said John Rowby the said Barrel Staves pipe staves Hoghead staves and fifteen Barrels of pork or any or either of them in the Condition of the said writing Obligatory mentioned as the said Mary in her plea hath Alleged and this he prays may be enquired by the Country. and the doct: in like manner . . .

Therefore Command is to the sheriffs of the County that Immediately he should cause to come before his Lordships Justices at a Court now here held at dividing Creek in and for the County Twelve by whom and who neither to Recognize because as well and the Jurors of that Jury being called some of them to wit Thullen Hill, David Bolch, John Woodford, Edward Roake, Thomas.
