All which day here came the d^r John Tunstall by Robert Jenchins Henry his attorney and the
sheriff to witt John Henry gent: nowhere Reftined that he had taken the d^r Sarah Ros whose
body hereal this day he had Ready to answer the d^r John Tunstall of the d^r plea as to him it
was Commanded

Whereupon the d^r Sarah Ros puts in her place George Douglas gent: attorney at law
against the d^r John Tunstall of the afo^r Plea

And thereupon at the Request of the parties d^r. day is to them now here given untill
next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County d^r. the third tuesday of August then next
following in the same stals as at present savinge to this parties d^r. &c

All which day here came againe as well the d^r John Tunstall as the d^r Sarah Ros by
their attorneys d^r. And hereupon the said John declared against the d^r Sarah Ros in the
plea d^r. in form following Somerset Sarah Ros late of somerset County Widdow
Administratrix of all and Singular the goods Chattles and Creditts which were of Thomas Ros late
of the County d^r. deceased who died Intestate as his said was attached to Answer unto John Tunstall
of a plea of trespass upon the case &c

And Whereupon the same John by Robert Jenchins Henry his attorney complains that whereas
the d^r Thomas in his life time to witt the twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred thirty and six at somerset County d^r. was indebted unto the same John in the
sum of Twenty and four Pounds eight Shillings and four pence in gold currency of the province
of maryland and gives pounds and six Shillings in paper currency of the same Province for one
negro girl slave and also for sundry other Articles properly chargeable in an account by the
same John to the said Thomas at the speciall Instances and Request of the said Thomas before that
time
