

348 Ordered John Wildman Recover against the Def. Francis Porter his damages Ad. to the Def. two Pounds five Shillings Cur. money of Maryland by the Arbitrators Ad. Inform Ad. found as also Three hundred and Seventy Pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges to the same John Wildman at their Request by the Court here Adjudged and the Def. Francis in Mercy &c.

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that Ad. Sarah Ros Admin. . . . he should take Sarah Ros late of Somerset County Widow Administratrix of Thomas Ros . . . of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits which were of Thomas Ros late of the County Ad. deceased who died Intestate as his said Ad. should be found in his bailiwick and her should safe keep so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing week the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ~~forty~~ forty nine to answer unto John Tunstall of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. and the same day is given to the Ad. John here &c.

All which day here came the Ad. John Tunstall by Robert Jenckins Henry his attorney and the Sheriff to with John Henry -- Gent: now here Returned that he had taken the Ad. Sarah Ros whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the Ad. John Tunstall of the Ad. plea as to him it was Commanded

Whereupon the Ad. Sarah Ros puts in her place George Douglas Gent: attorney at Law against the Ad. John Tunstall of the Ad. Plea.

And thereupon at the Request of the parties Ad. day is to them now here given untill next Court to be held at dividing week in and for the County Ad. the third Tuesday of August then next following in the same state as at present saving ^{to} the parties Ad. &c.

All which day here came againe as well the Ad. John Tunstall as the Ad. Sarah Ros by their attorneys Ad. And hereupon the said John declared against the Ad. Sarah Ros in the plea Ad. in form following. Somerset Sarah Ros late of Somerset County Widow Administratrix of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits which were of Thomas Ros late of the County Ad. deceased who died Intestate as his said was attached to answer unto John Tunstall of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c.

And Whereupon the same John by Robert Jenckins Henry his attorney complains that whereas the Ad. Thomas in his life time (to wit) the twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred thirty and six at Somerset County Ad. was indebted unto the same John in the sum of Twenty and four Pounds eight Shillings and four pence in gold Currency of the provinces of Maryland and five pounds and Six Shillings in paper Currency of the same Province for one negro girl Slaves and also for sundry other Articles properly chargeable in an account by the same John to the said Thomas at the speciall Instances and Request of the said Thomas before that time
