Orphans the sum of thirtyfive pounds ten shillings one penny according to Act of Assembly and the
Decd. will when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same & then the above obligation to be -
void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue.

At Francis Allen Junr. command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Robt
Geddes late of Somerset County Inholder if he should be found in his baileywick and him should safe-
keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be
held at dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of Novem^r. Anno Domⁱ one thousand seven
hundred and thirty nine to answer unto Francis Allen Junr. of a plea of trespass upon the case &c. And the same day is given to the
aforesaid Francis Allen Junr.

At which day here came the aforesaid Francis Allen Junr. by Francis Allen Senr. his Attorney and the Sheriff
to wit John Henry Bent nowhere returned that he had taken the aforesaid Robert Geddes whose body here at this day he had ready to
answer the aforesaid Francis Allen of the aforesaid plea as him it was commanded

And hereupon the said Robert Geddes putt in his place George Douglas Gent. attorney ^{at law} against the aforesaid Francis
Allen Junr. of the aforesaid plea - Whereupon at the request of the parties aforesaid day is to them here given until next
Court to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next following in the same State as at present saving to the
parties aforesaid.

At which day here came again the parties by their attorneys aforesaid and hereupon the said Francis
Allen Junr. complained against the aforesaid Robert Geddes in the plea aforesaid in form following.
