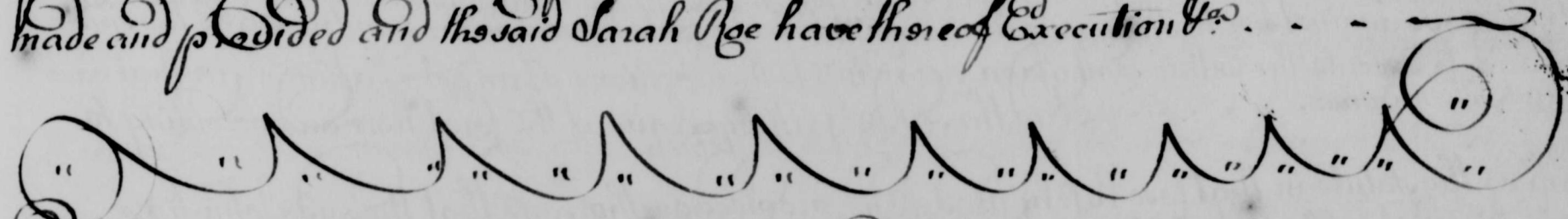


March Court 1740 90

William Gray, John White, Richard Wallis came and were sworn upon that Jury and because one of the Jurors of that same Jury did not appear therefore another of the standers by herunto elected by the sheriff of the County of ^{the} at the Request of the ^{the} John Tunstall and by the Command of the ^{the} Justices is newly put on whose name to the pannel within written is affixed according to the form of the statute in such Case lately made and Provided which said Juror so newly put on (to wit) John Burnall Jr. being called Likewise came who to say the truth of the premises ^{the} together with the other Jurors ^{the} first Impanelled and sworn being elected tried and sworn; and of their Verdict thereupon by the Court were charged and between themselves to Commune from the bar here did Needs and afterwards the same Jurors thereof between themselves agreed to their Verdict of and upon the Premises ^{the} Render to the bar here returned upon, which the ^{the} John Tunstall altho' Solemnly called Cometh not nor is his will ^{the} against the said Sarah Age further prosecuted . . .

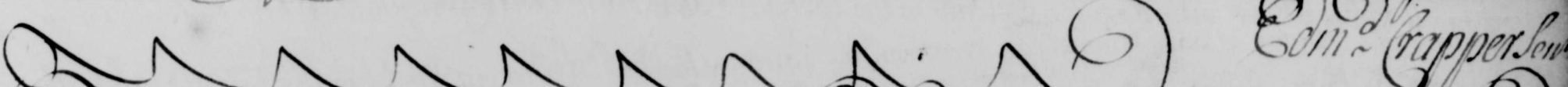

We the Subscribers being nominated and appointed by the worshipfull Court of Somerset County to direct and Lay out a road viz. from Deer Hammocks to the Road that leads through Senepuron neck we order and direct the following Road from the said Deer Hammocks keeping the south side of the Land near the marsh and up a glade a little below where Whale lived crossing the said glade on the south side of it on a ridge leaving a large dead Swamp on the right hand directly to the Road that lead through the neck from the point upwards given under our hands the 30. day of July 1740.
