Solemnly Called brings not in the body of the aforesaid John Price according to the Return of the writ Afd. but makes default &c

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take William King late of Somerset County Inholder otherwise called William King of the County of Somerset of Province of Maryland if he should be found in his bailwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty to satisfy Levin Gale Esq. Executor of the testament and Last will of Timothy Atkinson decd. as well a certain debt of Sixty nine pounds of good and lawfull money of the province of Maryland which to the same Levin in the same Court before the Justices thereof at dividing Creek recovered against him as of three hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco which to the same Levin in the same Court were adjudged for his damages which he had by Occasion of the detention of the same debt whereof he is Convict. and the same day is given to the Afd.
