And the aforesaid Henry Lawrence in his proper person cometh and desideth the force and Injuring when &c and
prayeth leave thereof to Imparle here until next Court to be held at Durdig Green the third Tuesday of November then
next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John here also &c.

At which day here came again as well the aforesaid John Henry by Robert Jenkins Henry his Attorney as his aforesaid
Henry Lawrence in his proper person and whereupon the said Henry Lawrence prayeth further leave thereof to Imparle here
until next Court to be held at Durdig Green the third Tuesday of March next following and he hath it and the same day is given
to the aforesaid John here also &c.

At which day here came again as well the aforesaid John Henry by Robert Jenkins Henry his Attorney as the aforesaid Henry
Lawrence in his proper person and whereupon the said Henry Lawrence saith that he cannot deny the actions of the aforesaid John
Henry nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid John Henry aboveagainst him hath complained
and as to the damage of the same John by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Henry Lawrence saith and
acknowledgeth that the aforesaid John hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his
suit in that part opposed to twenty pounds three shillings and six pence halfpenny and not more and because the aforesaid John denies not
this but the same allegations grants to be true per his judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his costs and
charges aforesaid to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by consent of the parties aforesaid it is considered that the aforesaid John Henry recover against the aforesaid Henry Lawrence
his damages aforesaid to the sum of twenty pounds three shillings and six pence halfpenny there hundred and fifty five pounds of tobacco
by the same Henry in form aforesaid acknowledged as also:

of tobacco for his costs and charges aforesaid to the same John at his request by the Court now here of the present of the parties aforesaid
adjudged and the aforesaid Henry in mercy &c.

His Lordship the Lord Proprietary that now is for the Body of Somerset County aforesaid upon their
oath do present that Thomas Selby of late of Coventry Parish in the
said County of Somerset Planter and William Selby of late of Coventry parish
aforesaid in the County aforesaid Planter the seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and forty with force and arms at the parish aforesaid in the County
aforesaid seven Tinkers of the price of twenty pounds of tobacco each Tinker of the Goods
and Chattels of a certain James Longo then and there found them and there feloniously
did steal take and bear away contrary to the peace of His said Lord Proprietary that now is
his good rule and government and against the form of the act of Assembly in such case lately
