Thereupon the said Samuel Adams together with Collins Adams of Somerset County planter his Security both present here in Court in their proper persons Acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the said James Britt in thirty pounds first money of Maryland of their body's goods or Chattles lands or tenements severally to be made and levied to the use of the said James Britt his heirs and assigns If it happen that the said Samuel Adams do not during the term aforesaid learn his said apprentice the trade of a house Joyner and to read write and cypher as far as the rule of three Inclusive and do not at the Expiration of his servitude give him a new suit of Cloaths either of Kersey or Druggel and do not provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing lodging and Cloathing sufficient for such and apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid
