Judgment of Cognovit Actorem

Charles County vs Thomas Wilson late of Charles County who was attached to answer
 under John Lawson the plaintiff of the party upon the case
 that when as the said Thomas on the first day of October in the year past Lord one
 thousand seven hundred and fifty five at Charles County aforesaid was indebted unto
 the said John in the sum of Nineteen Shillings and six pence Sterling viz. ten and
 fifty five pounds of Tobacco for divers articles lying properly in account as by a
 certain bill account thereof with intobacco brought may appear and the said Thomas
 being so then of and in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the said Thomas
 in the county aforesaid upon himself assumed and to the said John then & there lawfully
 promised that the said John should have the said sum of Nineteen Shillings six pence Sterling of the
 said Thomas and fifty five pounds of Tobacco to the said John well and truly content
 they when heunto a few days before he should be required never to help the said Thomas his
 promise and assumption aforesaid made in the least regarding but minding
 and fraudulently intending him the said John in his trust craftily & seditiously to deceive
 and defraud the said Thomas the said sum of Nineteen Shillings six pence Sterling of the
 said Thomas and fifty five pounds of Tobacco any part thereof the said John hath not
 paid or many words contented the said Thomas as was on the first day of March
 in the year past Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty five and after the said
 at Charles County aforesaid by the said John requested but the said Thomas the said sum of
 Nineteen Shillings six pence Sterling and fifty five pounds of Tobacco
 or any part thereof to the said John to pay or in any sort to content both his bills and to gather
 up and take the refusal to the damage of the said John one and Nineteen Shillings six pence
 and fifty five pounds of Tobacco and therefore he brings suit vs the said John do
 hereby certify
