

June Court Anno Domini 1747

Charles County ^{Sh} Whereas it has been made appear to the said George Robinson in writt directed unto Thomas Thompson grand Juror of the County of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty five Acres of Tobacco and that the said George Robinson has removed from the Place of his late abode and has departed the Province of Maryland

These are therefore in his Majesty the Lord Proprietors, Name & Command you to give Attachment against the Effects of the said George Robinson as well to satisfy the said sum of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty five Acres of Tobacco as also the President Order that shall arise thereon hereof you are not to fail at your Duty and for your so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant given under my hand the 21st Day of March 1746

Whereupon it was commanded the Sheriff that of the goods Chattell Credits of the said George Robinson in his Writt with being his should attach and the sum of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty five Acres of Tobacco Damages fifteen Hundred Acres of Tobacco for Costs that he had incurred and that further should do in Prosecution of the same and when the same he had attached or any Part thereof that he should have it before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his said County Court to be held at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in April next then it shall be condemned according to Law to and for the use of the said Thomas Thompson unless the said George should come then & there or his Lawfull Attorney and answer unto the said Thomas as of plea of Writt upon the same, and that by God and Lawfull men of his Writt with he should make known to the Person or Persons in whose hands he should make the same Attachment that he should be ready before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at that time and time afo. to show Cause if any he should or they have why the same in their or any of their Hands attached should not be condemned according to Law and that the said Thomas have the Writt Execution of 80. and how he should shew that Writt that he should make known to the Justice afo. at the Place and time afo. and that he should have the Writt that Writt 80.

And now here at this day to wit the second Sunday in June afo. comes the said Thomas by Writt in pl. have his attorney offers himself against the said George in the Writt and the Sheriff returns to the Court here the Writt afo. Writt endorsed by
