 you to give attachment against the Effete of the said James Scott as well to  
 take off the said Sum of Tenster Pounds Two Shillings & two Pence Current  
 money as also the Incidents Costs that shall arise thereon pursuant to  
 the provisions of Statute of Assembly in such cases made and provided first  
 and for saying this shall be a Warrant given under my hand this 25<sup>th</sup> of  
 March 1747

To the Sh. of Charles County

Whereupon I was Commanded the Sheriff that by the good Charles Chatter Credits  
 of the said James Scott in his Writ with being he should attach as well the sum of  
 Tenster Pounds Two Shillings and two Pence Current money Damages as Two  
 thousand Pounds of Issues Costs that had arisen and that for the said issue in  
 Prosecution of the Premises, and when the same he had attached any to. Altho' that  
 he should have it before the Justice of the said County of his said County Court to be had  
 at Charles Town on the second Tuesday or Wednesday next then and there to be examined  
 according to Law and for the said Sheriff & his Deputies & his Attorneys to be  
 ready that should come then and there to his said Sheriff and answer unto his  
 said Sheriff & his Deputies & his Attorneys upon the Case and that by good & full  
 means he should with his Deputies & his Attorneys to the Sheriff or Persons in whose hands  
 he should make the same Attachment that he or they should appear before the  
 Justice of the said Lord Propriety at that time and time safe. For the Cause of any of the  
 or they have why they are in their or any of their hands attached should not be  
 Examined according to Law and that the said Sheriff and his Deputies & his Attorneys  
 of the said County should execute that Writ that he should make known to the Justice  
 of the said County and time safe and that he should have then and there that Writ & the  
 Names of those before whom he should make the same known as
