And whereupon the same Samuel by Jeremiah Chase his attorney complains that whereas the said John Thom Jun. the Eleventh Day of June in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and forty five at Charles County aforesaid was indebted to the said Samuel in the sum of Three Pounds five Shillings and seven Pence half Penny Currency for such things as by Property in an account as by the Particular Account thereof here within to Court brought may appear and being thereof indebted the said John in consideration thereof afterwards for the day and year ap. at the County aforesaid upon himself appeared and to the said Samuel then and there faithfully promised that he the said John Thom Jun. the said sum of Three Pounds five Shillings and seven Pence half Penny Currency to the said Samuel within three months of time and should be requested, well and truly would content and pay. Nevertheless the said John Thom his Promise and assumption ap. not regarding subverting and fraudulently Intending the same Samuel in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the said John the said sum of Three Pounds five Shillings seven Pence half Penny Currency or any part thereof to the said Samuel hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort contented altho. the aforesaid John afterwards for the first day of August in the year and at the County ap. by the same Samuel was requested but the same to him to pay for him for the same in any sort to content hath hitherto altogether refused and still doth refuse to the Damage of the said Samuel Six pounds Ten Shillings Currency and therefore suit is brought and so forth
