Company with Henry Davis Henry Woodyard and John DeLozier
Thereupon the said Robert Haislip
Present herein Court in his proper person being asked whether
he be guilty of the Trespass and breach of peace ^{ap^d} upon him
Imposed saith that he is in no wise thereof guilty but for that
He will not contend with his Lordship the Lord Proprietary
In this part Humbly submit himself to the Court

Therefore it is Considered that the ap^d
Robert Haislip before the sum of forty Shilings Current money
For the offence ap^d by the Court here adjudged and that the said
Robert betaken of ^{Charles county Gent} Whetellport into Court here in
his proper person Comes ^{Magistrate} and becomes Pledge
And security for the ap^d Robert Haislip to pay the fine ap^d
And also the several fees arisen due to the officers and ministers
of the Court here by occasion of the Premises.

It is Ruled that the said Robert Haislip
Recognize in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money
with sufficient security in the sum of Ten ^{pounds} like money for his good
behaviour at the next County Court to be here holden on the second Tuesday
In June next.

Thereupon Into Court here in his proper
person Comes the ap^d Robert Haislip of Charles County Plander and
William Matthews of Charles County Tenant and acknowledged them
selves to owe and stand Justly Indebted to the Right Honourable the
Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Robert In the sum of Twenty
Pounds Current money and the said William In the sum of Ten
Pounds like money which sums they and each of them severally
And granted should and might be levied on their and each of their
Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to and for the use of his
said Lordship his heirs and successors.

The Conditione of which Recognizance is
That if the above bounden Robert Haislip shall personally
Appear at the next County Court to be holden for this County to do
And Receive what shall be then and there Injourned him by the said
Court and in the meantime that he be of good behaviour towards
(wards)
