 It is Remembred that heretofore to wit the second
 Tuesday in June by the Act of Assembly in Novis Namely Thomas Matthews & Co
 was Granted Catherine Winn selling Liquor under her own House contrary to
 Act of Assembly — Now nowhere at this day to wit the second Tuesday in
 August 1727. That Catherine in custody of the Sheriff Namely Samuel
 Johnson Comd to the Court here being held in her Keeper Mason James & being
 Demanded of her by the Court here in that she is Guilty of the Breach afo^{re} above afo^{re} her
 Impound the said Catherine say she is there Guilty in manner and form as by
 the Breach afo^{re} against her it is alleged

Therefore it is Considered that
 Maria Catherine Winn be fined for selling & bearing money for her offence afo^{re}
 by the Court here & Judges and the said Catherine be taken & C^o

Whereupon into Court came his
 Proper Person Comes John Bingham of Charles County Planter & became
 Pledge and Security for the said Catherine to pay the fine afo^{re} as also the Court fees
 & costs due to the officers and ministers of the Court here by occasion of the Premises
